

EXCEPTIONAL FOOTBALL GAME ADMINISTRATION AWARD CRITERIA

During crew postgame conference an evaluation is conducted. At end of the season all members are offered an opportunity to nominate schools for recognition based upon the below criteria. Nominations must include comment and are submitted to the NHFOA council for selection of Exceptional Football Game Administration. Selected administrators are invited to attend the first Saturday of December, NHFOA President's Reception.

PRE-GAME COMMUNICATION (Referee-AD):

Does AD or rep return your calls or emails in preparation for game?

Is a written game day itinerary provided?

PARKING / TRANSPORTATION

Locker Room Parking: Does school provide reserved parking near locker rooms?

Game Field Parking: Does school provide reserved parking at game field?

Post-Game Exit: Is escort or assistance provided for quick & easy vehicle exit from field?

ESCORTS:

Is school representative available to guide officials to locker room?
