

**2012 Summer Business Meeting
July 24, 2012
Pinkerton Academy**

The meeting was called to order by President Richard Driscoll at 6:34 PM.

President Driscoll introduced the members of the NHFOA Council.

President Driscoll welcomed the members, coaches and guests to the meeting.

Councilor and Rules Interpreter Steve Hall presented the 2012 NFHS rules changes and interpretation and concluded with the points of emphasis for the year, which are concussions, illegal helmet contact, correct helmet fittings and preventing heat illness.

Assistant Mechanics Supervisor Jeff Delois presented the mechanics presentation and discussed the upcoming clinic which would be held, once again at Memorial High School where we members of the NHFOA would assist in a game-like scrimmage for educational purposes.

Secretary Paul Smith reported that with 131 members present, the NHFOA did have a quorum.

Secretary Smith moved the adoption of the proposed bylaws change which simply re-ordered the layout of the bylaws. It was seconded by Brian Snow and adopted by voice vote.

Treasurer Jim Presher presented his financial report to the membership and yielded to questions. Sec. Smith moved the adoption of the report; it was seconded by Councilor Mike Lafond and adopted unanimously.

Councilor Lafond moved the adoption of the 2011 Annual Business Meeting minutes; it was seconded by Treasurer Presher and adopted unanimously.

President Driscoll presented former Councilors Begley & Dickson with plaques for their service to the Council and Association at large.

President Elect Paul Page was recognized to discuss the uniform dress code revision. He reiterated that sunglasses were prohibited for wear during contests unless there is a documented medical necessity. He also suggested that white shorts were no longer to be part of the usual uniform code.

Curriculum committee chair Neil Vogler announced the area coordinator names as: Manchester-Lafond, North Country-Presher, West-Zeccha, Seacoast-Peyrot, and Nashua-Sevigny.

Commissioner Ernie Clark gave his report which touched on ejections, uniforms, prep-school procedures, saluting the flag at games. He elaborated on testing and game assignments and stated that self-assign would open on August 16 and that the first month of the season's schedule would be out shortly.

There was no old or new business to come before the Association.

The 50/50 winners were announced with the outstanding leadership of Gerry Veileux.

With nothing further to come before the Association, Brian Snow moved to adjourn; it was seconded by Councilor Lafond and adopted by unanimous vote. The meeting stood adjourned at 8:06 PM.
