As part of that effort, I co-authored a complete re-writing of both the Constitution and the Bylaws in order to ensure that both documents were up-to-date, organized correctly, and contained the appropriate articles and provisions necessary for the efficient governance of the NHFOA. I have provided assistance and consulting to several members who have proposed amendments to the Constitution and Bylaws, including assistance in drafting such amendments. I provide this service in order to ensure that the language of a proposed change to be considered by the membership is consistent and does not conflict with any existing provisions of either document. I provide this assistance even if I do not agree with the proposed change.

I have also served as rules interpreter for the last 21 years and I am an active member of the NFHS Football Rules committee, representing New Hampshire's interests. I've received several suggestions from members for proposed rule changes over the years, and I have submitted many of those rule changes to the NFHS, most of which have been adopted by the Rules Committee.
