

NHFOA Council Meeting
May 23, 2013
PSNH – Manchester, NH

The meeting was called to order at 5:56 PM by Chairman Richard Driscoll. In attendance at the meeting were Councilors Sevigny, Hall, Driscoll, Lafond, Robert, Vogler, & Colburn. Also in attendance were Commissioner Clark, Treasurer Presher & Secretary Smith.

The minutes from the April 25, 2013 minutes were adopted by unanimous vote.

The correspondence report from the Commissioner included a letter from Jeff Rosen that he is in fact, retired and a note from Tom Joseph requesting to be classified as an associate member.

Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$20,027.65 as of May 13. The report was adopted as reported, subject to audit.

Commissioner Clark presented his report which included discussion that the NHFOA did very well with NHIAA Early registration, officials need to know the expense of the additional \$80 if they don't register on time. Schools have been very slow in submitting their schedules. Next meeting of the NHIAA coming in June will allow the association to see the contract before signing.

New Business: 1-Welcomed Jeff Delois to discuss mechanics: has upcoming meeting planned with committee, want to set up a standard second half choice option, will be working on the 9th grade question of sidelines (which is the NHIAA mandate), he asked about tracking sideline warnings through the season and the council seemed to think that was a good idea. August 17 mechanics clinic at Manchester Memorial High School, possibly bringing back NFL referees for 2014. 2-Councilor Hall moved to accept Joseph's request for associate membership, which was adopted unanimously.

With nothing further to come before the Council, Councilor Lafond moved to adjourn, the motion was adopted and the Council stood adjourned at 7:40 PM.
